AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A TRESILLIAN PROGRAM

I agree / understand:

- To work collaboratively with staff regarding my care and the care of my child/children.
- To be involved in the development of a Family Care Plan and to review this with staff throughout my stay.
- To discuss with staff ways in which my goals may be managed appropriately.
- To comply with Tresillian safety standards and procedures.
- That Tresillian is a teaching organisation and I do / do not accept students as members of my caring team
(consent for student attendance will be discussed at the start of each session)

HEALTH INFORMATION AND PRIVACY

I agree / understand that:

- Health information will be treated in accordance with the NSW [Health Records and Information Privacy Act 2002](#) and the NSW Health [Privacy Manual](#).
- Registration details and clinical documentation related to my time in the VRPS program will be recorded in Sydney Local Health District's electronic health record.
- Discharge information will be shared for the purposes of ongoing care with the referral agent, my General Practitioner and other providers involved in my and my child's care, such as child and family health services.
- If referrals to other service providers are made with my agreement, that clinical information will be shared with them to support ongoing care.
- That Tresillian staff are mandatory reporters and are required by law to report suspected child abuse and neglect to government authorities under NSW's *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*.
- I am entitled to request access to my and my child's health information that is held by Tresillian.
- Data from the clinical records will be used for administration purposes, internal quality assurance, auditing, service evaluation and research.
